



## **Circular No. (14) of 2022**

## **Covid-19 Pandemic Precautionary Measures Update** at Federal Government Level

## To: All Ministries and Federal Entities

The Federal Authority for Government Human Resources (FAHR) extends its best regards to you all, wishing you sustained health and safety.

Further to the Circular issued by FAHR, No. (5) of 2022 regarding Covid-19 Pandemic Precautionary Measures Update at Federal Government level, and in line with continued decrease in Covid-19 infections, as well as for the purposes of unifying all provisions related to precautionary measures in terms of responding to the pandemic, and in coordination with the National Emergency Crisis and Disasters Management Authority (NCEMA) and Ministry of Health and Prevention, it has been decided to start working on the second phase of scaling back the procedures set for dealing with COVID-19 pandemic as of the 7<sup>th</sup> of November 2022, as follows:

- Abandoning putting on masks in all open and closed places.

  It is still mandatory to put an analysis in the still mandatory to be a still It is still mandatory to put on masks in healthcare facilities and establishments and People of Determination' centers. of Determination' centers.

  Cancellation of the green pass requirement to enter federal entities and public sites.
- Limiting the use of Al Hosn application to authenticating vaccination certificates and tests' results inside and outside the state, upon request.
  - Limiting the isolation period to five days for those infected with the Covid-19 virus.

Wishing safety for all, FAHR points out that these procedures and provisions are subject to update and change based on the latest requirements issued by Health Authorities, and in coordination with the Authorities concerned with emergencies and crises. Finally, FAHR shall save no effort to support federal authorities on any aspects related to this circular, providing the following channels for communication.
