Invitation for Applications for the Ph.D. Program in Strategic Studies

Applications are invited for entry into the Ph.D. Program in Strategic Studies offered by the National Defense College scheduled to convene on 14 August, 2016.

The deadline for application is May 12, 2016.

1. Curriculum

The doctorate in strategic studies at the National Defense College is designed to produce practitioners skilled in analyzing complex security challenges who are capable of offering practical and innovative solutions to modern problems and ready to lead institutions through rigorous strategic decision-making. This intensive post graduate program is structured to prepare students for high level careers in government, academia and the private sector.

The academic coursework builds around four pillars of security, diplomacy, political economy and resource policy, and governance/leadership, as well as on fundamental disciplinary requirements in analytical methods, critical thinking and advanced strategy. A National Defense College Doctorate in Strategic Studies signifies theoretical, methodological and substantive expertise in the elements of statecraft fundamental to the advancement of domestic, regional and international security.

2. Doctoral Program Objectives

The NDC Ph.D. program has five primary objectives:

- 1. To enhance the college as a leading institute that contributes to the development of strategic thinking.
- 2. To promote the development of strategic and security studies at national, regional and international levels.
- 3. To develop highly qualified faculty members and other experts for service in the UAE.
- 4. To establish shared concepts for military and civilian leaders and to develop strategic and security thinking as well as requirements for decision-making.
- 5. To develop student abilities to think critically and strategically and apply practical knowledge in order to develop and resource strategies for peace, crisis and war.

The scientific analysis resulting from the dissertations written in this Ph.D. program will help senior officials of the UAE plan for and deal with future strategic challenges and opportunities.

3. Doctoral Program Learning Outcomes

The desired outcomes of the Doctorate in Strategic Studies (DSS) program are intended to produce in NDC graduates the ability to:

1. Critically evaluate current and future strategic environments, threats and challenges at the national, regional and international levels in order to facilitate effective national decision-making.

- 2. Demonstrate evidence of expert original research and creative scholarly analysis in order to develop studies and analyses to meet the needs of the nation.
- 3. Apply fundamental theories of strategic thinking and frameworks based upon enduring international security principles to produce either specialized strategies (diplomatic/military/economic/informational) or national comprehensive strategies in response to strategic national challenges and opportunities.
- 4. Evaluate, using relevant scientific research methodologies, a strategic issue of importance to the nation in order to create recommendations to advance the national interests.
- 5. Evaluate the use of national resources and the processes and systems of governance in order to develop innovative solutions for future strategic challenges and opportunities.
- 6. Synthesize and clearly articulate comprehensive expertise in strategic issues supported by scholarly rationale and scientific evidence.
- 7. Serve as strategic leaders who can consistently and sensitively develop and implement effective policies and strategies in support of national security objectives.

4. Doctoral Program Admissions Criteria

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- 1. A minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale in the applicant's previous master's degree program.
- 2. Demonstrate proficiency in at least two languages, one of which must be English (minimum TOEFL score of 550 [213 CBT, 79-80 iBT] or 6.0 IELTS). A copy of a TOEFL exam taken within the last 2 years is required.
- 3. Have earned a Master's degree in a related field from an accredited institution.
- 4. Provide three letters of reference assessing the applicant's suitability for doctoral coursework and research.
- 5. Submit a personal statement of 500 words describing the applicant's academic and professional experience, goals, and motivation for pursuing the Ph.D. degree.
- 6. Submit an academic or professional writing sample that demonstrates the applicant's experience with and capacity for graduate level research and writing.
- 7. Provide a current CV.

Top applicants will be interviewed by members of the college doctoral admissions committee and the senior leadership of the college.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
