## On Education allowance for UAE students in private schools

To: All Independent Federal Entities & Authorities

The Federal Authority for Government Human Resources (FAHR) would like to send you kind regards, wishing you all the success in your endeavors.

Pursuant to the Council of Ministers' Resolution No (41 m / 7 m) for 2016 organizing enrollment of UAE students in private schools with "poor" and "very poor" performance, which contains several items, including:

- To stop the imbursement of education allowance granted by any of the federal government entities for UAE students enrolled in private schools that are classified as "low performing", to be effective as of the beginning of the academic year 2016/2017
- Payment of 50% maximum of education allowance grated by the federal government entities students enrolled in private schools with unacceptable performance, with effect from the academic year 2017/2018.

For the purpose of implementing the above Cabinet Resolution, and in line with stated policies of Education & Human Recourse Council, FAHR would like to request all ministries and federal bodies to implement the above two items, and advise the relevant departments to coordinate directly with the Ministry of Education, Knowledge Authority and Human Development Authority in Dubai and Abu Dhabi Education Council, in order

to identify the private schools that are classified as low or acceptable performing for the purposes of implementing the above two items.
