

Circular N0 (37) for 2015 regarding holiday for Martyr's Day and UAE National Day

To: all federal government ministries and entities

On the occasion of the upcoming Martyr's Day, which falls on 30 November and UAE National Day, which falls on 2-3 December, may both occasions return with blessing and prosperity;
