What the Portal Offers:

- Access and apply for training opportunities across federal entities.
- Track applications and training progress online.
- AI-powered matching of skills to suitable opportunities for a smoother training experience.

Objectives:

- Support and qualify national talents.
- Develop practical skills for graduates and students.
- Enhance professional readiness.
- Foster a culture of experiential learning.

Training Duration: 3 months

Key Roles:

- **Students/Graduates:** Register, complete training, and document achievements.
- **Federal Entities:** Provide opportunities, supervise training, and evaluate performance.
- **Educational Institutions:** Coordinate academically and support students.
- **FAHR:** Maintain the portal and ensure its strategic goals are met.

Using the Portal:

Trainees go through several stages, starting with creating a personal account and browsing available training opportunities, followed by submitting an electronic application, obtaining entity approval, beginning the training, monitoring performance, and finally submitting achievement reports for the program.
