Accordingly, employees of the federal government can communicate and request support for mental and moral advice through one of the approved communication channels to obtain employees discount or sometimes free consultations, or to obtain a discount includes employee families from first class (spouses, children and parents) when using the paid services.

"Hayat" program is based on following main points:

- Promoting institutional awareness of the importance of mental and moral health of employees.
- Enabling the employee to achieve a balance between work and social life with and to make sure providing the necessary moral and psychological care for all employees.
- Create the required balance for employees intellectually, physically, and emotionally.
- Emphasizing the values of compatibility between institutional and functional goals on the one hand and personal aspirations on the other.
